### EASTER

Easter is coming up, you might be wondering what people are doing for Easter this year. Are we going to go places and die eggs and hunt eggs? There's a quite chance that we can do that but we have to wear our masks and of course stay 6 feet apart. Easter is a special holiday; if you want to know what Easter stay tuned because it's coming up.

What is Easter? If you forgot or didn't know what Easter is all about, I'm about to tell you. Easter is a Christian holiday that celebrates the belief in the resurrection of Jesus Christ. In the New Testament of the Bible, the event is said to have occurred three days after Jesus was crucified by the Romans and died in roughly 30 A.D. The holiday concludes the "Passion of Christ," a series of events. If you don't believe in God it's ok, you can still celebrate Easter.

When is Easter? People have been wondering when is Easter, well I'm about to tell you. Easter 2021 occurs on Sunday, April 4. However, Easter falls on a different date each year. It may seem like it's on the same date, but it's really not. Easter always falls on a Sunday between March 22 and April 25. Easter typically falls on the first Sunday after the first full moon occurring on or after the Spring Equinox. In Eastern Orthodox Christianity, which adheres to the Julian calendar, Easter falls on a Sunday between April 4 and May 8 each year.

Why is Easter called Easter? Eostre, or Eostrae, the Anglo-Saxon goddess of spring and fertility, inspired the English term "Easter." Others argue that the word "Easter" comes from in albis, a Latin term plural for alba, or "dawn," which became eostarum in Old High German, a forerunner to today's English language.

Why do they call them easter eggs? The egg, an ancient symbol of new life, has been associated with pagan festivals celebrating spring. From a Christian perspective, Easter eggs are said to represent Jesus' emergence from the tomb and resurrection. Easter egg hunts and egg rolling are two popular egg-related traditions.

### SAINT PATRICK'S DAY

Saints Patrick's Day is coming up, you might find gold!! So go get a bucket, and find a rainbow. If you don't know or you forgot what Saint Patrick Day is I'm about to tell you all about it. Though it marks the anniversary of the death of the Patron Saint of Ireland, St Patrick, was not Irish but born in England. Kidnapped to Ireland at the age of 16, as a slave!

While the festival is now a four-day affair in Ireland, and Dublin, it is home to the world's biggest parade. The first parade was held on the streets of Boston in 1732, to help Irish soldiers serving in American colonies to reconnect with their country. Today, the New York City Parade is the biggest one outside of Ireland, though the most fun celebration is in Chicago, where they dye the Chicago River green.

The original color associated with St. Patrick was blue. It is believed that over the years, it changed to green, to commemorate St. Patrick's use of the shamrock in his holy teachings. Finding That Lucky Four-Leaved Clover, in case you don't find that four-leaved clover today, don't fret. Did you know that only one in 10,000 clovers have four leaves? According to Irish folklore, each leaf means something. - The first represents hope, the second represents faith, the third represents love and the fourth represents happiness.

According to the Guinness Book of World Records, the highest number of leaves recorded on a clover leaf is 14.

How to Catch that Sneaky Leprechaun  
According to Irish mythology, the Leprechaun, (whose name comes from the mixture of 'small person' and 'one shoemaker') is a small fairy that knows the location of a pot of gold.
